Rita will be teaching Breastfeeding Skills and Spanish for Birth Professionals and she has been a midwife since 1984. She studied at the Santa Fe Midwifery School, and The Maternity Center in El Paso, Texas. Rita has been the primary midwife in over 800 births, and has been present during more than 3,000 as a doula or midwife preceptor in Puerto Rico, the US, and Central America.

She has trained traditional midwives in underdeveloped countries with Inciativa Comunitaria de P.R. Rita is also licensed as a Paramedic with the Puerto Rico Health Department.

She has trained over 500 people in her roles as a Lactation Consultant for the WIC program in Puerto Rico. She is the founder of Doula Caribe en Puerto Rico through which she has trained and certified over 400 doulas.

Her passion is the time she spends with her family, especially her 20 and 14 year-old daughters and her husband of 27 years, Jeff who is an archaeologist in the Regional Office of the Forest Service. Rita and family came to Portland in the Fall of 2009, and are enjoying the change immensely. She is very enthusiastic about becoming a Birthingway faculty member.


Join us in our Breastfeeding Center for some light snacks and lots of helpful information to steer you down your path to becoming an IBCLC.
