Gatherings News



Our Lactation Consultant Training and Breastfeeding Counselor Programs are well on their way.

We currently offer the 45 hours of Lactation Specific Education necessary for IBLCE Eligibility Pathways 1 (Peer Counselor or Licensed Healthcare Professional) and 3 (Mentored Clinical Hours). We have a full class for our Winter Breastfeeding I class and are excited to support our students as they seek mentorships or go on to take more classes to fulfill the requirements for our one year Lactation Specific Education Program.

Our one-year certificate is still being developed, but many of the necessary classes are already available. Register for Medical Terminology or Anatomy and Physiology to get started.
