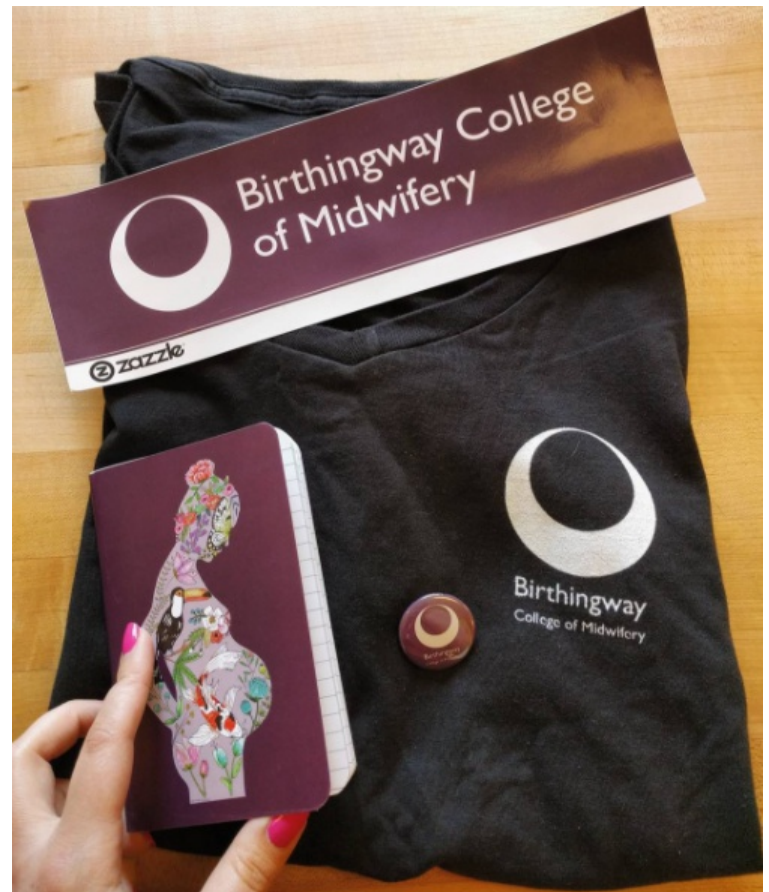

#### Definitions:

- **Enrolled Student:** A person who has applied to a program at Birthingway, been accepted, and completed enrollment paperwork. This includes students in the Midwifery, Lactation Consultation, Childbirth Education, Labor Doula, and Postpartum Doula programs.
- **Community Student:** A person who is not enrolled in a program at Birthingway but takes courses or workshops.

#### General Registration Policies:

- Registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Registrations which are received before the registration start date and time will be processed at the end of the day on the registration start date.
- Walk-in, faxed (fax #: 503-760-3332), or mailed registrations will be date/time stamped in order of receipt. **If you fax in your registration, please call us at 503-760-3131 to confirm that it has been received.** If your fax doesn't go through, your registration will not be complete and could also result in late fees or not getting a course you need.
- If paying through **PayPal**, you must include a copy of your PayPal payment confirmation or your registration will be considered incomplete and delayed until the confirmation is received.

#### Registration Information for Enrolled Students:

- All enrolled students must register each term to maintain their enrollment status.
- If you are planning to **graduate** or **certify** this term you must still turn in a completed registration form and full payment for your Registration Fee and Tech Fee (and Late Registration Fee if you're registering after the Registration Deadline), even if you are not taking any credits.
- **Enrollment Confirmation Deadline:**
  - If you have not registered by the Enrollment Confirmation Deadline, you will be withdrawn from your program at Birthingway.
  - Eligibility for **financial aid** is based on your enrollment status as of the Enrollment Confirmation Deadline. We use this date to determine whether you are attending full, 3/4, half, or part time, and your corresponding financial aid award. No changes are made to your financial aid award after this date except in limited circumstances. For more information, see the *2017-2018 Student Handbook and Catalog*.

#### Payment, Good Financial Standing, and Financial Aid:

- Good financial standing means that all charges are paid when due. If you are not in good financial standing, you will not be allowed to register for courses or workshops in a new term, have a transcript released, or graduate.
  - >> **If you are not in good financial standing**, you may still register for the term to remain in your program (paying only your registration and technology fee, and late fee, if applicable).
- Payment of tuition and fees is due at the time of registration for each term unless the following applies:
  - Midwifery Program Students Only:** You are eligible for Federal financial aid and will be receiving a disbursement in that term. (You must have a completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and a signed award letter on file at Birthingway showing a disbursement in that term.)
  - Lactation Program Students Only:** You have a written payment plan in place or you have a private student loan through a private lender and will be receiving a disbursement in that term.
  - Midwifery and Lactation Program Students:** You have been approved for Veteran Education Benefits to attend Birthingway and will be receiving benefits for that term.
- Textbook and equipment kit charges are due when ordered, unless you are receiving a Federal financial aid disbursement or private loan disbursement in the term and have authorized payment from your financial aid disbursement. All overdue amounts are subject to a finance charge of 15% APR with a \$5 minimum per month. Any costs incurred to collect these amounts are the responsibility of the student.

## **Courses open to all students**

### **Anatomy and Physiology for Birth and Lactation Professionals (ANP151q) 5 credit hours**

***This course meets Midwifery Program prerequisite requirements.***

Using lecture, weekly exams, and student presentations, this course covers all the major body systems with an emphasis on knowledge relevant to perinatal practices. Beginning with basic cellular function and a brief review of A&P vocabulary, students will progress rapidly through each body system, focusing on how the body functions in wellness, but also addressing some pathologies.

### **Botanicals II (BOT332q) 3 credit hours**

***Prerequisite: Botanicals I (BOT231q)***

This course uses the knowledge gained in Botanicals I on actions and constituents to discuss materia medica and herbal therapeutics for fertility, preconception, pregnancy, intrapartum, and postpartum. This course uses a variety of teaching tools including lecture, discussion, case studies, and student research.

Students will have opportunities to deepen understanding of their own brains and how their attachment histories and relationships impact communication with clients and preceptors. Students also begin to identify the impact of the client's attachment history and ways to help them feel safe in potentially intense experiences of birth, breastfeeding, and parenting.

**September 14, 2017- December 9, 2017**

All courses have a minimum of 5 students and a maximum of 16 students unless otherwise noted.

### **Introduction to Breastfeeding Theory (BRF131q) 3 credit hours**

*This course replaces Breastfeeding I (BRF111q) and Breastfeeding II (BRF222q)*

Using lecture, discussion, visual aids, and small group activities, this course provides students with basic information about normal breastfeeding physiology of mother and baby, properties of human milk, risks of formula feeding, recommendations regarding breastfeeding initiation, duration and normal parameters of nursing in the first two weeks, politics of breastfeeding, and influences of culture and birth practices on breastfeeding. Students will also have opportunities to utilize case studies and research projects to develop skills such as how to take a breastfeeding history of mother and baby, identification of presenting problems, and integrating counseling and education strategies into their breastfeeding support.

### **Medical Terminology (MED111q) 1 credit hour**

*This course meets Midwifery Program prerequisite requirements.*

Dissecting medical terms into recognizable word parts, students decipher what can be an intimidating language, in order to chart appropriately and communicate with other medical professionals. This class is an overview of anatomy, physiology, and pathology, focusing on the language of A&P. Lectures weave in related stories of pregnant women and babies, individual presentations, while a few games spice up the memorization.

### **Perinatal Psychology for Midwives (PSY221q) 2 credit hours**

This course explores the psychological tasks associated with the childbearing year, such as shifts in personal identity, working with pregnancy dreams, prenatal depression and anxiety, working with client fears, the psychological impact of the birth experience, the importance of the "birth story," working with birth trauma and postpartum depression, changes in the couple relationship, and some of the psychological challenges that midwives may face.

Students expand their knowledge from Plant Medicine I, learning about and making topical applications, preparation of herbal baths, hydrosols, succi, salves, and creams. They add to their plant monographs and enhance their plant identification skills through in class activities and a field trip.

Additionally, students will explore a wide range of cultural beliefs and practices regarding the childbearing year.

Students will have an opportunity to create their own cases to present to their peers, as well as solving differential diagnosis scenarios. Includes all pieces of the consultant's practice such as history taking, assessment, charting, plan development, and follow-up.

Skills covered in this course include maternal resuscitation and continued practice of I.V. Skills. This course meets Legend Drugs and Devices initial education requirements for treatment of shock and for adult and infant CPR for Oregon midwifery licensing.

This course covers methods for evaluating fetal well-being, including monitoring and analyzing fetal heart tones using a doppler or fetascope, fetal movement counts, sonogram, Auscultated Acceleration Test (AAT), the Non-Stress Test (NST), the Biophysical Profile (BPP), Amniotic Fluid Index (AFI), and other methods.
